

## Earswick Parish Council Neighbourhood Plan Working Party Record of Discussion of the Meeting held on Thursday 26th May 2016

### Discussions held:

1. WG opened the meeting by confirming that there was a quorum present.
2. AT presented the draft results of the Earswick Neighbourhood Plan Residents Survey No 2. He confirmed that a return of over 60% of the questionnaires was excellent and in general the responses fully supported the WP. He highlighted a few anomalies in the responses without divulging any confidential data. The WP thanked AT and his team for their hard week.
3. The WP discussed the forthcoming residents meeting of 6th June and it was agreed that WG would provide the introduction with input from DJ and supported by a PowerPoint slide produced by AT. The goal of the introduction is to clearly spell out the objective of no growth in the Green Belt and no changes to the Green Belt boundary. Brown Field areas within the Parish will be highlighted for the benefit of residents.

4. The financing arrangements for the Neighbourhood Plan were discussed due to the fact that a recent request for a grant had been rejected. It was determined that the remaining grants should be adequate to cover all expenses. SW was requested to follow up about the £3,000 grant from CYC.

5. Target dated for future actions were discussed but some of these will be dependent on the timing of the CYC Local Plan milestones.

6. The next milestone is to aim to submit the Draft Neighbourhood Plan to CYC before the end of July 2016.

7. It was agreed that AT and the WP members would meet at the Village Hall at 6pm on 6th June to conduct a dry run of the presentation.

The meeting was closed at 21.15 hours.

The date of the next meeting is towards the end of June and will be confirmed by email from WG.
